British Youth Championships (BYC) Qualifier



Venue: The Sennocke Centre, Sevenoaks School, High St, Sevenoaks TN13 1HU

Date: Sunday 29th January, 2017

Age Groups: U12 - 2005/6, U14 - 2003/4, U16 - 2001/2, U18 1999/2000

Format: 1 round of poules followed by DE, no cut.
Subject to numbers, poules may be mixed, but not by weapon size. All DE's will be separated.

Eligibility: You must be a member of British Fencing South East Region. Resident in UK. You may only fence in 1 region's event. You can enter multiple weapons, including both Foil and Sabre.

Closing Date: 20th January 2017

Entry Fee: £35.00 (late entries £40.00 at organiser's discretion)

What to expect in 2016/2017:

- Qualified Referees
- No additional fee for qualifiers
- New style trophies for places 1-4
- Refreshments Stand, Spacious Hall, Free Parking
- Armoury

Equipment: A minimum standard of 350N/CEN1 mask with back strap, jacket and breeches for all ages and a plastron of 350/CEN1 for U12/U14 and 800N/CEN2 for U16/U18 is obligatory, as are long socks.

Foil: Lame foil bibs with connecting straight wire are compulsory for U16/U18 and may be used for U12/U14. U12/U14 - max blade size 3, U16/U18 - 5.

Sabre: U12/U14 max blade size 2, U16/U18 5. 800N/CEN2 gloves obligatory for U16/U18 sabre.

Information for qualifiers to BYC Finals: Minimum of 4 qualifiers per event, not including those with a BYE. The British Youth Championship Finals 2017 will be held at the EIS Sheffield, 29th April - 1st May, 2017. If a fencer wishes to turn their place down the next fencer may be offered the place on the day - please plan in advance. Any fencer who reached the L8 in their event at last year's BYC Finals (inc U10) may claim bye in this championships, but they must enter the regional qualifying competition. A reduced fee of £30.00 will apply if not competing in regional event. A Parental Consent form will need to be filled in electronically prior to the finals event and will be available on the BFA website, along with a list of qualifiers. Warning: BFA will send communications to the email address on a fencers membership profile - make sure it is up to date!
